






















# Boston

<p><b>Salem Wax Museum and Witch Village</b></p>	<p>This compelling museum is composed of eerily life-like London made wax figures that depict Salem's vivid history from its founding in 1626 through the terrifying Hysteria of 1692 along with a 15 min guided tour concerning the myth versus the reality of witchcraft in both the ancient and modern world.</p>
